are largely obstructed by the use of multiple layers of indirection. The current characterization of malicious cyber campaigns based on indicators of compromise, such as file hashes and command-and-control infrastructure identifiers, allows a malicious operator to evade the defenders and resume operations simply by superficially changing their tools, as well as aspects of their tactics, techniques, and procedures. Hi Friends,

Thanks again for your willingness to serve as a PC member. Such service is time-consuming, hard work! We know that at times it may not seem rewarding, but we thank you (on behalf of our community) for your efforts! With that in mind, I'm going to repeat some of what I said last year: remember that serving as an academic gate keeper is a privilege, and with that power comes responsibility. Indeed, "the scientist invested with the mantle of the judge cannot be arbitrary in his or her judgment and must be a constructive critic" [Richard Smith 99]. All too often we lose sight of the fact that peer review is, by definition, an evaluation of scholarly work by peers, and it is intended to be a mechanism of self-regulation that assures that not only standards of quality are met **\*but that we encourage improvement and advancements in our field\***.

Undoubtedly, as you evaluated the papers before you, the quality of the writing, the perceived significance of the thesis developed, the inherent interest of the subject and fit for the conference, and the originality and quality of the work all influenced your recommendation. That's how it should be; your role is in ensuring an appropriate mechanism of checks and balances is in place that upholds expected standards, double-checks arguments, and treats all papers fairly. In that sense, the peer review process is more helpful (in my opinion) in improving what is eventually published than as acting as gate keepers for sorting the wheat from the chaff.

And as gate keepers, we all tend to prioritize novelty in our adjudications. That's good. After all, we all seek knowledge. But, we'd like you to keep in mind that perceived novelty can be subjective. As you continue to deliberate the merits of the works under consideration, try to be open and unbiased in your assessments.

Take risks on those works that go off the beaten path. Additionally, remember that many of the authors have been thinking about their submitted work for months (at least, I hope so), while many of us may have only been thinking about the technical aspects of their papers for a few days. Thus, give them the benefit of the doubt where possible. On that, most of you have done a FANTASTIC job in offering advice on how to address criticisms raised about aspects of a paper, and we look forward to seeing more of that constructive criticism during the PC meeting.

Regarding the PC Meeting on Thursday May 26:  
-----

To ensure judicious use of our time, the PC meeting will be used (almost exclusively) to handle borderline cases for which consensus was not possible in the written and online discussion phases --- despite your best efforts to do so. Hence, we are looking to you for a healthy discussion that convinces your fellow colleagues of a paper's merits or shortcomings that can (or can not) be saved. It's time to break the circle of being pit-bull reviewers. We all want to receive

narratives that are thoughtful and constructive rather than what seems to be the norm these days --- dismissive reviews :( We owe it to our community to do better, and I know you guys can help break this cycle. Seriously, I will be counting on you to do so! (And per Marc's email, please do take time to rate the reviews now that the context of the papers is fresh in your mind.)

The PC meeting will start sharply at 9am in the **Fairfield room, located on the ballroom level of the hotel**. Coffee and light breakfast will be available from 8:30 in the meeting room. The discussion leads on papers have been (mostly) set in the online system, so please be sure to check the papers you will be leading the discussions on. We will be updating the leads and papers to be discussed over the next few days.
